- A **NEW** virtual workplace social skills program designed to increase the likelihood of employment longevity for individuals with autism and similar disabilities.

JobLINX © is a newly available workplace social skills program created to increase **self-advocacy and employment longevity** for individuals with autism and similar disabilities. This innovative program was created and piloted with a cohort of employees working with FedEx in Cypress, TX. The program creator had seen many young adults with autism begin jobs only to quickly be let go because of social mistakes. JobLINX© aims to provide individuals with crucial workplace social skills knowledge as well as a community of peer mentors and support.

- 20 weeks of social skills training and employment support
- Weekly one-hour virtual classes led by highly qualified instructors
- Workplace social skills curriculum targeting skills necessary to retain employment
- Weekly one-hour virtual peer support meetings
- Pre- and post-program self-evaluations
- **30 hours workplace readiness training** and **10 hours self-advocacy instruction**

CONNECTED: ECCCO CAREER DEVELOPMENT CURRICULUM

This curriculum resource is designed to help all students build the necessary skills, knowledge, and networks for a successful transition beyond high school. Students participate in career exploration and preparation experiences, building skills in and applying knowledge of industry best practices, all designed to increase student engagement.

T-FOLIO CURRICULUM

T-Folio is an online transition portfolio tool for high school-age youth with disabilities. Activities are student-centered and emphasize the youth's role as a leader in setting and achieving goals for the future.

Counseling on Post-Secondary Education ----- 30 hours

CONNECTED: COLLEGE ACCESS CURRICULUM

This curriculum helps students start thinking about how they will feel successful in life. It will also guide students in thinking about and understanding what educational steps will be necessary to fulfill their goals. The curriculum will familiarize students with what colleges are looking for in applicants; introduce the concept of cost of attendance, what it includes, and how it differs by school; explain the four basic types of financial aid; and introduce how to think critically about how college is different from their previous educational experiences.

COLLEGE BOUND TRANSITION CURRICULUM

This curriculum is designed for students with learning differences. The materials are intended to teach students about college culture and living on campus at a college.

ME! CURRICULUM

The ME! Curriculum is a curriculum developed and made available for free through the University of Oklahoma's Zarrow Center for Transition and Self-Advocacy. The ME! Lessons for Teaching Self-Awareness and Self-Advocacy curriculum consists of ten units developed for the purpose of teaching critical transition knowledge and skills to high school students with disabilities.
